Who is it for?

Unaccredited

This Level 1 Food Hygiene and Safety course is designed for workers who are not directly involved with the preparation or handling of high-risk foods but work in an environment where food is present or handled elsewhere. This also includes those who work with wrapped or pre-packaged foods. For example:

Front of house employees.

Checkout staff.

Waiters.

Bar workers.

Food delivery drivers and riders.

Kitchen porters.

Low-risk food retailers (e.g. newsagents, sweet shops).

Warehouse staff.

If your role involves directly handling or preparing food, then you need to take Level 2 Food Hygiene and Safety (available for retail, catering, and manufacturing) in order to comply with food handlers' legal obligations.
